E M P L O Y E A C T I O N S	NUCLEAR	Time, Distance Shielding, Chances are remote that you will discover any radioactive material because a detector is needed to read the material. Notify proper authorities immediately.	Cover nose and mouth with a cloth. Do not touch, taste or smell. Do not ask another person to touch, taste or smell. Vacate the area immediately; notify other personnel to vacate the local area immediately.	Contamination depends on the exposure rate and time exposed, and type of radiation. Get as far away, as fast as possible, put something heavy between you and the source.	Emergency decon, wash, strip, flush with large volume of water, cover. Avoid contact with other persons until Deconned. Decon with mass volume of water, Seek medical attention immediately
	BIOLOGICAL	Unexplained rashes, flu like symptoms, dermal irritations. Notify proper authorities immediately	Cover nose and mouth with a cloth. Do not touch, taste or smell. Do not ask another person to touch, taste or smell. Vacate the area immediately; notify other personnel to vacate the local area immediately.	Bio hazards present two type of contamination; Direct exposure, inhalation, ingestion, contagious cross contamination	Emergency decon, wash, strip, flush with large volume of water cover, removed clothing should be bio-safety bagged. Avoid contact with other persons until deconned. Follow public health notice, seek medical attention.
	CHEMICAL	Sudden illness, dizziness, hyper secretions. Notify proper authorities immediately	Cover nose and mouth with a cloth. Do not touch, taste or smell. Do not ask another person to touch, taste or smell. Vacate the area immediately; notify other personnel to vacate the local area immediately.	Chemical contamination presents two types; Direct exposure to a solid or liquid and/or vapor exposure. Inhalation or ingestion	Emergency decon, BLOT, strip, flush with large volume of water, cover. Clothing should be bagged. Avoid contact with other persons until deconned. Follow public health notice, seek medical attention immediately.
	EXPLOSIVE	If you are far enough away, but involved in the shock wave, you may experience, dizziness, possibly nose or ear bleeding, dis-orientated.	Evacuate the area immediately	You may be contaminated with NBC depending on the event.	Decon as needed and or directed by officials.
	TELEPHONIC THREAT	Obtain as much information as possible. Use the FBI data card, ask important questions. Notify your supervisor immediately. Notify the proper authorities. Evacuate the area if appropriate; relocate to a safe place, upwind, uphill.
